

How to Get Anthologized!

Submit Your Poems to the 2004 WPA Anthology

Great news! The WPA is publishing a juried anthology and all WPA members are eligible to submit poems. Your two best poems will be blind judged by a panel of independent, non-member judges. We'll print their top selections (one poem per selected poet) in an anthology due out this fall. All WPA members will receive a copy of the anthology (whether you submit or not, and whether your poem is selected or not) – our way of saying thanks for being a member and supporting our mission to inspire the creation and appreciation of poetry.

THE RULES

1. Send two (2) poems to be blind judged by a non-member independent panel. (Don't put your name on your poems.)
2. Complete and send this entry form with your poems. (Be sure to include the titles of your poems on the form.)
3. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope (#10) for notification.
4. If you'd like confirmation of delivery, include a stamped, self-addressed postcard.
5. Open to all members of the Washington Poets Association.
6. OK to submit previously published and award-winning poems.
7. Limit each poem to 60 lines or fewer.
8. Poems won't be returned. Keep copies for your records.
9. Entries must be postmarked on or before July 1, 2004.
- 10. All members receive a complimentary copy of the Anthology!**
